**Gender and Human Rights in HIV and AIDS Education** is a toolkit developed through extensive collaboration 2008-14. This new resource is based on ecumenical conference recommendations in Tanzania in 2008, piloted in ecumenical training in Kenya in 2009 and successfully run in 2010 in Tanzania, 2012 in South Africa, 2013 in Burundi and 2014 in Ethiopia. With Scriptural references, it features a set of tools and methods for gender and human rights mainstreaming in organizations, as well as in programming and interventions for HIV and AIDS education. Available now, the toolkit can also be offered through **train the trainers’** workshops.

Since 2007, Southern African AIDS Trust and Frayintermedia have been collaborating with Canadian Churches in Action members and their partner organizations in Eastern and Southern Africa to tackle issues of HIV and AIDS, human rights and gender. This cooperation has resulted in this resource with a particular focus on men’s roles, using HIV and AIDS training.
